Report of Project



Background of TTC and Water Well condition

Tahan Theological College, established in 1978, is offering L.Th., B.Th., and M.Div degrees and there are 135 day students including 100 hostellers. By the providence and guidance of God, the location of college completely moved to the more spacious and well accommodating place in 2008.

Though there are several advantageous in new campus, it lacked clean water-supply system. The campus had to rely on not-deep-well which could not provide clear and healthy water particularly in rainy season. For the earth's surface water gets into the well, the water is not clean and causes skin infection among the students. The hostellers suffered that every year.

To meet this fundamental need of the campus, through the assistance of Angela Norton, partnership coordinator from Myanmar, PCANZ, the College received Ks. 3489000/- for clean water-supply project in November, 2010.

Before the project implementation, there is one water tower with 2000 ltr. Plastic Tank and plastic pipeline to distribute the water mainly to two a main administrative office, a class rooms building and three faculty quarters. At that time two hostels (boys and girls), and 3 staff quarters used hand-pump. Since a water-tank is not sufficient to supply the whole 10 acres large campus with its buildings. Therefore, the project responsible people Rev. Dr. Lalengzauva, General Secretary of PCM and TTC principal decided to drill two deep wells, one is under the already erected water-tower and another one is near girls' hostel.

Outcome of the project:



- 1) 2 deep wells: No. 1- 150 ft., No.2- 100ft. with clear water
- 2) 1 water-tower (20 ft. high with a 3000 ltr. Steel tank)
- 3) Plastic water pipe connection to Women Hostel, Men Hostel, Dining Hall, 3 Staff Quarters, Office Building, Class room Building, Library and 10 Water taps at TTC Park.



- 4) 2 Water pumping motors.
- 5) Sufficient clean water for the whole Campus all the year.

Beneficiaries: TTC community and those who use the campus for various purposes.
