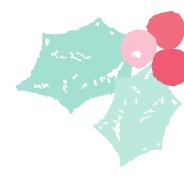

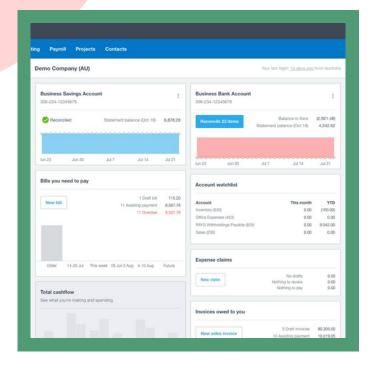


Assistance with setting up xero
